Just the other day I was sitting and relaxing when my Gram asked me why does she pay more than others who are on Enhanced Lifeline? At first I did not know what to say or what was the answer to her question. From that I was determined to find out everything and anything about Enhanced Lifeline. It turns out that with Enhanced Lifeline (\$18.50 towards your phone bill), your monthly basic phone bill rate will be approximately \$1.00 plus taxes and fees. If you choose to add additional features, those are in addition to your phone bill. For example, you choose to add call waiting which is \$2.50 then your phone bill will be \$1.00 plus \$2.50 along with taxes and fees.

Did you know that you could qualify for Enhanced Lifeline if you live on the reservation and participate in one of the nine programs listed below? You may also qualify if your household income is 135% or below poverty level also listed below. If you qualify you can go to our website www.gilanel.net and print out an application. After you have filled out the application, mail it to GRTI or come in and drop it off at the GRTI office in Lone Butte. For further information call Customer Service at (520)-796-3333.

- Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance
- Tribally-Administered Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TTANF)
- Head Start (Income Eligible Only)
- Nationally School Lunch Program's Free Lunch Program (Free lunch Meals)
- Food Stamps (DES- cash, family, general assistance)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance (Section 8)
- Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)
- Medicaid
- Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF)

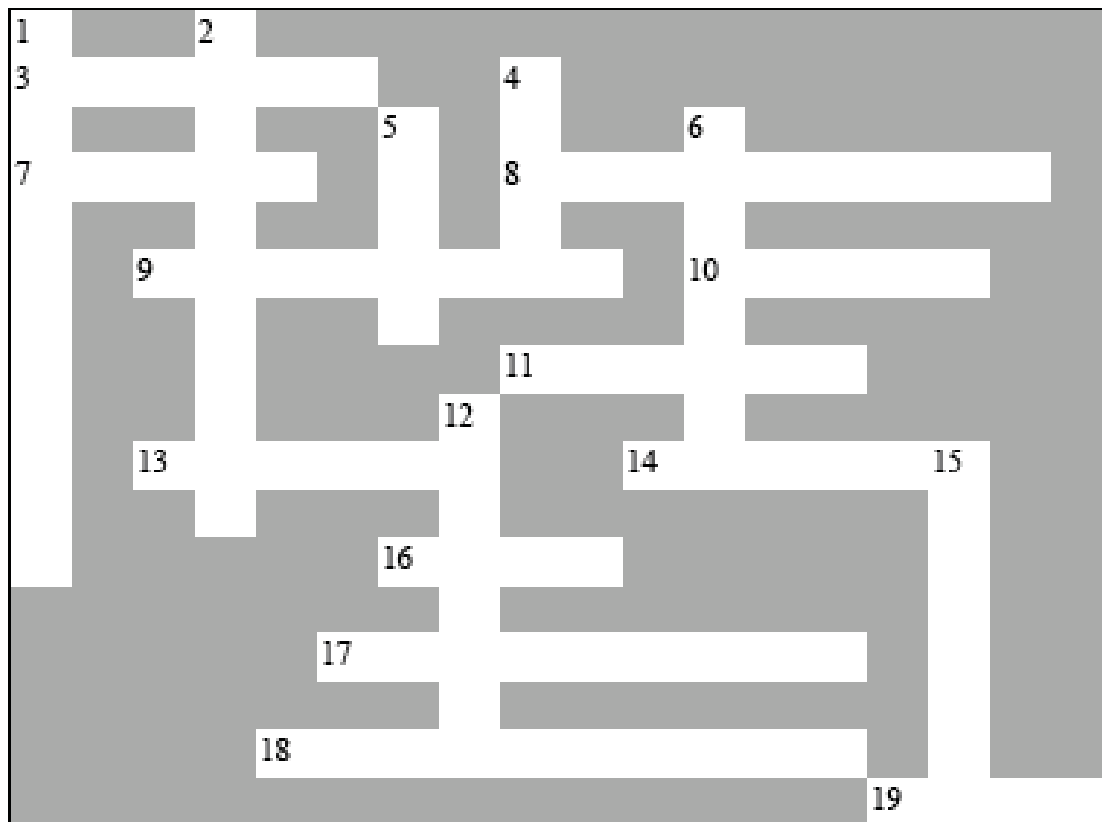

GRTI is now proud to present "eBill" a simple and convenient way to pay your bill online. Once registration is complete you will be able to login and view past payments, and call history, plus if you have a secondary account you will be able to keep track of those accounts too!

Instructions to get you started...

- 1) Go to the Internet page www.gilanet.net
- 2) Click on the eBill icon
- 3) Register your e-mail name & GRTI phone number, you must have an active e-mail account
- 4) Your password will be e-mailed to your e-mail address you registered with online
- 5) Use your bank or check card to pay your phone bill on the Internet with eBill
GRTI accepts Visa, Mastercard, Discover Card, and American Express for eBill payments

Note: For eBill payments you should receive an e-mail notification of the amount you paid. If you have not received your email notification then you may have either typed in an incorrect or inactive e-mail address. If you entered an incorrect e-mail address you will need to re-register with your correct or active e-mail.
