AlertOne[®] Emergency Response Systems

The **AlertOne** Program is sponsored by Gila River Telecommunications, Inc. (GRTI) and the Office of Special Funding of the Tobacco Tax Program. The **AlertOne** unit can be a very valuable tool in time of an emergency for an Elderly or Disabled person. The **AlertOne** unit is **FREE** to the Elderly and Disabled who live on the Gila River Indian Community.

The unit comes with one **AlertOne** box (about the size 5"x8") and a pendant to be worn around the neck. The red button on both the **AlertOne** box and the pendant can be pressed for emergency assistance. **AlertOne** box then dials 911, in which the police dispatch will be contacted. The **AlertOne** box must be connected to a phone line.

We encourage the Elderly and Disabled to wear the pendant around their neck at all times. The **AlertOne** pendant is waterproof and can be worn in the bath or shower.



Great for:

- People who live alone
- Disabled and elderly
- Family has peace of mind knowing there loved ones can call for help 24 hours a day.

Note: the pendant works in the home and a certain distance around the outside of the home. A walk test is given when installed to determine the distance the pendant works around the outside of the home.
